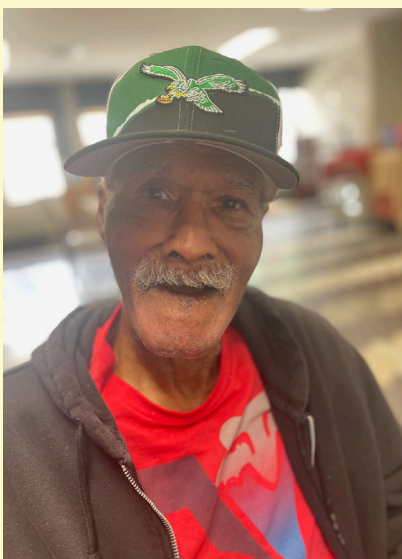

Mr. Roundtree, lovingly known here at Brookside as "Big Bad Billy," was born and raised in Philadelphia.

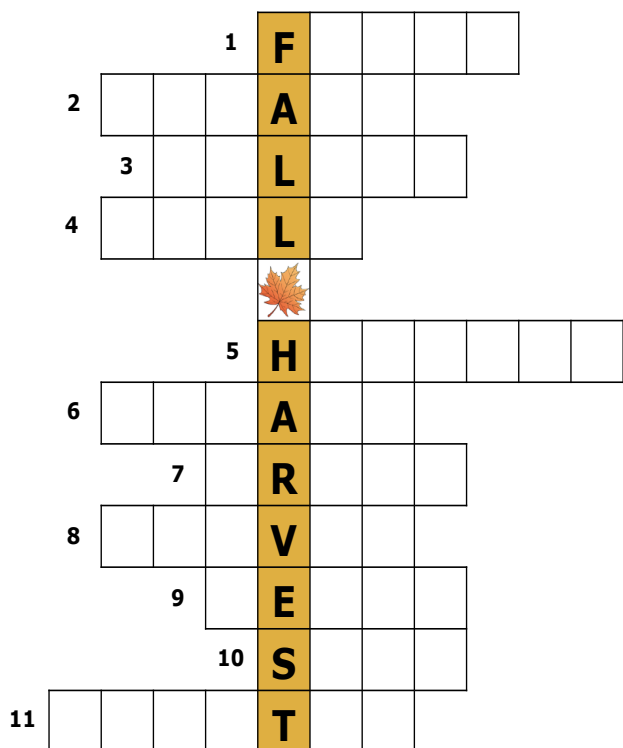

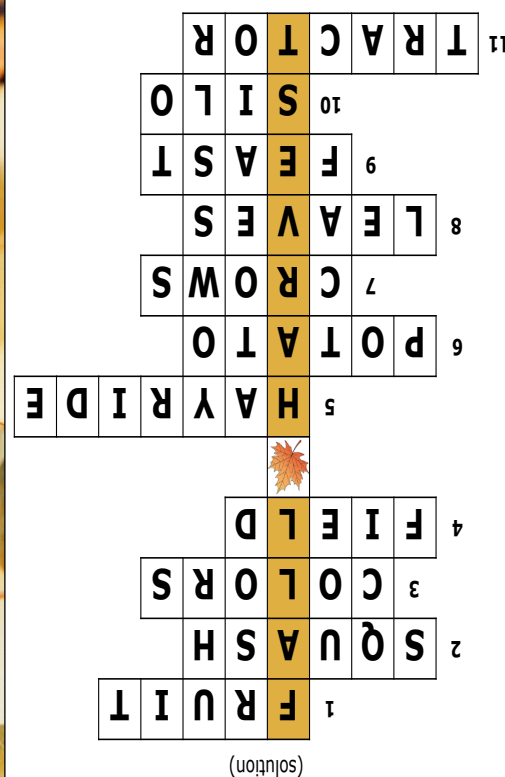
