Resident of the Month: Durrell Field

Durrell Field was born in Waterbury, Connecticut on March 4, 1943. He was one of two children born to Oliver D. and Marie Schutz Field. His family moved from Connecticut when he was 5 years old. He considers his older sister his role model as they grew up. His mother made sure they went to church every Sunday and observed the Lutheran religion. When his family moved to Wilmington, he attended Alfred I DuPont School (side note: all that remains of the school is a column and plaque, in front of the Concord Gallery Shops), Springer Middle School and Brandywine High School. He remembers a favorite Shop teacher, Mr. Brenner; he wore a wig and when frustrated would take it off and throw the wig on the ground. He also remembers two of his pet dogs, 'Spotty' because of the dog's spots and 'Tippy' because it had a small tip of a tail.

Over his lifetime, he has been a volunteer fireman with the Talleyville Fire Company; got involved with politics and met Joe Biden; and is a Veteran of Vietnam. Recently, Mr. Field was one of our 25+ Veterans that we honored here at Regency. Mr. Field served for four years and carried an M-16 while on patrol in Vietnam. Mr. Field has always been interested in electronics since a very young man. His first job was in TV repair; he apprenticed with Marcozzi TV repair and went to RCA School. He continues to 'talk shop' today. While being interviewed for this article, we reminisced about how today's TVs cannot be repaired and that the 'old stuff' would last for years and then, with a good repairman, would last a few more years! 
